# TOWN OF ENFIELD

## **Public Safety Subcommittee Special Meeting** **Wednesday, July 25, 2018-3:30 pm**

### 1. Called to Order

The meeting was called to order by Lori Unghire.

### 2. Review of Previous Meeting Minutes

It is mentioned that everyone received an emailed copy.

### 3. EMS Ambulance Replacement

Chris gives a brief overview/explanation as to how the replacement was approved and ordered to be 'on hold' pending funding. John Wilcox uses the CIP plan to explain the current process of leasing instead of buying on projects. A significant amount of money was cut from the EMS budget. It may be necessary to put a future transfer on the agenda in order to get the reserved chassis which will save us \$4000.

Gary Wiemokly explains the vehicle replacement plan that was inducted into the EMS process due to the dire condition of the ambulances. The replacements were part of the plan that is suffering because of budget cuts.

Chris suggests that we go ahead with the transfer. It is agreed.

### 4. Real Time Crime Center & 5. Security Camera Registry

The Enfield Joint Operations Center is an idea that was brought forward by Off. Emmons. Hartford has an impressive crime center that can be toured. The Enfield Center can be either physically manned or equipped with things like cameras and shot spotter systems.

Security camera registry would be the first and a no cost option. A camera at Elm and Rt 5 would cost around \$17,000.

### 5. One Way Streets

Southwestern Thompsonville is an area of most significant criminal activity concern and can be better managed if some streets are made one way. This idea should be brought to Council due to the large amount of resources involved.
