Carl Robinson Update

Warden Murphy stated the facility is running well. They are still adding razor wiring and updating the lighting. Specific areas had new boilers put in. The inmates will be helping to set up for a Glastonbury little league tournament. They helped Willard Cybulski set up the GHO, which Willard will be taking over in 2019. The facility is running very well. They have a program with 10 Yale law professors teaching the prisoners that started a few weeks ago.

Willard Cybulski Update

Willard Cybulski has a new furlough program with Whitcraft Group in Eastford, CT. The graduates from Asnuntuck are going out on furlough to work. The company is taking them there and picking them up. The program just started today. The fall Asnuntuck program is up and running with 19 prisoners.

NEW BUSINESS

Chairman Nowak reminded the Warden's that DA Quiros said he could obtain the minutes from the Somers prison meetings for the Committee to review.

Chairman Nowak questioned if the puppy program was still going on.

Warden Murphy stated the puppy program is still going on but has been moved to Osborne.

Chairman Nowak noted the next meeting will be December 12, 2018.

Warden Murphy stated they can have the meeting at the conference center.

Mr. Slade questioned if the investigation related to the prisoner escape was complete.

Warden Murphy stated the state police is not complete before they make a decision on discipline.

Mr. Slade noted he had heard that changes were made to prevent this from happening again and confirmed with Warden Murphy that the changes have been made.

Mr. Edgar motioned to adjourn at 6:10 PM, Mr. Slade seconded the motion. All were in favor.
