7. Junk Mail
8. Flattened Cardboard & Brown Paper Bags
9. Plastic Bottles & Containers #1-7
10. Telephone Books

- **Plastic Bags / Food Liners** are accepted at local grocery stores
- **Textiles** - Textile Bin available at the Department of Public Works and Transfer Station.
- **Electronics and Scrap Metal** - Containers are located at Transfer Station Only.
- **Hazardous Waste, Motor Oil, Paper Shredding and Batteries** - Check the website for specific dates.
- **Paint / Paint Cans** - Sherwin Williams at 85 Freshwater Blvd., Enfield
