# Detailed Itinerary

- 1 **Your** journey begins with a non-stop overnight flight from the U.S to Reykjavik, Iceland on Icelandair.
- 2 **This** morning you'll be greeted at the airport and escorted to a restaurant at a nearby village for your welcome breakfast. Following breakfast you'll head to the capital for your panoramic Reykjavik city tour and take in the cities major attractions. Highlights include the old town, the Cathedral, the Asmundur Sveinsson Sculpture Museum, the Pearl, the Hofoi House, and the city's main landmark, the Hallgrimskirkja. Transfer to your hotel and enjoy the afternoon at leisure. Later this evening embark on an included Northern Lights (Aurora Borealis) excursion in search of the entrancing and magical display of beautiful colors across the night sky. If the forecast is suboptimal this evening, your Reykjavik Northern Lights excursion will be rescheduled for another evening. (B)
- 3 **Today** we have a fascination full-day excursion where you'll discover the Snaefellsnes Peninsula in the West of the island with its white and black sand beaches, bird cliffs, spectacular mountains, volcanic craters and charming fishing villages. The spectacular Snaefellsnes Peninsula has captured the attention of people across the globe, as it was featured in the famous science fiction novel "Journey to the Center of the Earth" and in the critically acclaimed movie "The Secret Life of Walter Mitty" starring Ben Stiller. (B)
- 4 **After** breakfast, begin your journey through the stunning landscapes of Iceland's south coast. This is the land of Njal's Saga, a region of breathtaking scenery and legendary stories. During your guided excursion, you'll encounter the wonderful variety of the south: from the wide plains formed by glacial rivers to the dramatic sea cliffs of Dyrholaey to the spectacular waterfalls of Seljalandsfoss and Skogarfoss. Along the way, you'll also savor unforgettable views of the Hekla and Eyjafjallajokul volcanoes and the beautiful village of Vik, Arrive at your countryside hotel. Later this evening, simply leave your hotel room for an excellent opportunity to see the Northern Lights (Aurora Borealis) in this remote part of Iceland. Vik is considered to be one of the most magical places to take in a Northern Lights experience. Hotel Katla (B,D).
- 5 **This** morning, depart on a journey through some of Iceland's most spectacular and noteworthy sights as you make your way back to Reykjavik. Your first highlight of the day is the hot spring area to see the famous Geysir and Strokkur, a magical hot spring that spouts every few minutes. Get your cameras ready for an exciting show! Onwards to Gullfoss (translated as "Golden Falls"), Iceland's most famous and impressive waterfall featuring a spectacular double cascade. Your next stop is Thingvellir National Park, where the ancient Viking parliament met for centuries on the shores of Iceland's largest lake. Here, you can also witness the geological phenomenon of tectonic plates coming apart. Later, return to your centrally-located hotel in Reykjavik and enjoy an evening at leisure. (B)
- 6 **Day** at leisure in remarkable Reykjavik to explore independently or participate in the optional excursion of your choice. This evening, enjoy a farewell dinner with your group where you'll celebrate your experience in incredible Iceland. (B,D)
- 7 **Morning** at leisure before checking out of your hotel and heading to one of the highlights of the Iceland experience – the world-famous Blue Lagoon. This amazing natural spa is based around the unique properties of the geothermal seawater in the lagoon. The geothermal water originates 2,000 meters below the surface, where freshwater and seawater combine at extreme temperatures. The water has a unique composition of three active ingredients — Silica, Algae and Minerals — and the blue color comes from the Silica and the way it reflects sunlight. You can enjoy a drink while you relax in the lagoon, position yourself under the waterfall, apply a Silica mud mask, or simply enjoy the healing powers of the Blue Lagoon. After your geothermal experience, you'll transfer to the airport and board your return flight to the USA. Your memorable journey comes to an end as you touch down in the USA later today. (B).
