Maintaining the infrastructure that supports electric lines is one of the many ways Eversource ensures the safe, secure transmission of electricity throughout the region.

Work in Your Neighborhood

Since your property is near this project, we're making sure to let you know of upcoming work. The work at the Scitico Substation, 20 Bailey Road, Enfield, CT, includes replacing circuit breakers. The project will be located entirely within the substation, on Eversource property.

What You Can Expect

First, we want you to know that this work will not interrupt electric service to your property, and that people working on this project carry proper identification at all times.


Crews working for Eversource will be starting construction at the substation on October 11, 2017. We expect to complete the project by November 30, 2017. There will be increased truck traffic to the substation from time to time for delivery and removal of equipment.

Our construction team typically works Monday through Saturday between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. Work on Sunday may be needed for system restoration. Due to weather or other unexpected circumstances, the schedule may change.
