

UTILITY TREE TRIMMING SCHEDULED TO START IN MARCH

Starting in March, Eversource will begin trimming trees from around power lines in selected neighborhoods around Enfield. This tree trimming effort is primarily in response to the 2011 storm and helps prevent power outages by removing branches and trees that are either too close to power lines, or pose a risk of falling on power lines.

The tree trimming will begin in March and, weather permitting, completed by the end of the calendar year. Eversource's contractor, Asplundh, will be performing the work.

Eversource is required to obtain homeowner consent prior to trimming trees on private property. Cut wood or mulch produced as a result of the tree work is available to customers free of charge.

The Town has a map of the streets that will be affected on the Town website, under "Department of Public Works."
