PUBLIC NOTICE

A team of assessors from the Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies (CALEA) will visit Enfield from March 2 through 5, 2020 to examine the Police Department's policy and procedures, management, operations and support services.

Verification by the assessment team that the Enfield Police Department meets the Commission's state-of-the-art standards is part of a voluntary process to achieve accreditation, a highly prized recognition of law enforcement professional excellence. The Department received its initial accreditation through CALEA in 1996 and is seeking its seventh re-accreditation. Accreditation is for four years, during which time the Department must maintain compliance with standards and submit yearly reports to CALEA. In addition, a CALEA Compliance Service Member verifies compliance annually.

As part of the on-site assessment, agency employees and community members are invited to offer comments directly to assessors at a public information session to be held at:

Once the CALEA assessors complete their review of the Department, they will report back to the full Commission, which will then decide if the agency is to be granted accredited status.
