Call to Order & Pledge of Allegiance

Chairman Fiore called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM.

Roll Call

Commissioner Petronella took the roll and present were Commissioners Lewis Fiore, Virginia Higley, Linda DeGray, John Petronella, Kiran Majmudar and Alternate Commissioners Christian D'Antonio and Nicles Lefakis. Absent was Commissioners Francis Alaimo and Kenneth Hilinski.

Chairman Fiore seated Alternate Commissioners Lefakis and Grillo for Commissioners Hilinski and Alaimo.

Also present was Georgienna Driver, Assistant Town Planner and Rebecca Jones, Recording Secretary.

Approval of Minutes

- a. July 28, 2022 – Regular Meeting

Motion to accept the July 28, 2022 regular meeting minutes made by Commissioner Higley; seconded by Commissioner DeGray and approved by 6-0-2 vote. Commissioner Lefakis and Alternate Commissioner Grillo abstained.

New Business

- a. Regulation Review

Ms. Driver reviewed the regulations and the agency's role in the community. She confirmed all commissioners have a copy of the regulations and noted that special conditions can be included by the commissioners so long as they are within their jurisdiction. Chairman Fiore confirmed that the Town of Enfield did receive an extension from the State of Connecticut to ensure all appropriate businesses are registered. Ms. Driver explained that this program was enacted around 2008 and many businesses did not renew their registration after the 5 year period was up. She estimated that 90% of businesses affected fell out of compliance. Since being hired at the Town of Enfield, Ms. Driver has been working with these businesses to renew their registration and received forgiveness from the State of Connecticut for the fees incurred from falling out of

compliance. All but 4 businesses are back in compliance and a new inventory has been submitted to DEEP to show this. Ms. Driver shared outstanding projects and their statuses.

b. APA Property Updates

Scott Daigle and Clifford Daigle, 8 Dusthouse Road, were present for discussion. Ms. Driver has been working with Mr. Daigle to bring his site back into compliance. Mr. Daigle shared different tactics he has used to change his site to become more ecologically sound. Chairman Fiore thanked Mr. Daigle and requested that he continue to work with staff to avoid state intervention. Mr. Daigle asked for staff to investigate the curb cut on Dusthouse Road as the water is draining into a pond on his property. Ms. Driver shared findings from a historic file found regarding the road reconstruction. She will investigate it further and get back to Mr. Daigle and the commissioners.

Adjournment

Motion to adjourn made by Commissioner Higley; seconded by Commissioner DeGray and approved by a vote of 7-0-0.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:55 PM.
