ROADS 2015 STREET RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT

TO: Residents / Landowners
FROM: Town of Enfield Department of Public Works
RE: Maple Avenue, Spring Street - Upcoming Roadway Improvements
DATE: March 17, 2020

On behalf of the Town of Enfield, Hinckley Construction, Inc., of Enfield, Connecticut, has been contracted to reconstruct the following streets:

- Cross Street, Maple Avenue, Pease Street, South Street and Spring Street.

On or about Monday, Monday 23, 2020, the Contractor will start sewer work on Maple Avenue and then will be continuing onto Spring Street. The entire contract work includes road reconstruction, repaving of the roadway surface with hot mix asphalt overlays, replacing catch basins, replacing catch basin tops, installing new drainage pipes, installing new sanitary sewer pipes, resetting existing utility structures, installing pavement markings, installing new signs, driveway reconstruction, sidewalk replacements, concrete sidewalk ramp construction, and other incidental work.

The following are some things to you should expect:

- Before any excavation starts, you'll see paint marks in the road and survey stakes in front yards. These are used as reference points for the Contractor's work. The stakes are intentionally set back from the work area and outside the actual limits of excavation so that they aren't displaced during the excavation process. You should not assume that the stakes indicate the new edge of road.
- Because these roadways will be reconstructed, all the driveway aprons will need to be cut and a portion of front yards within the Town's Right of Way will have to be disturbed in order to accommodate installation of the new road elevation. The Town will make every effort to minimize the portion of driveways and front yards disturbed.
- **All driveway aprons will have a 1" to 1.5" lip at the edge of road to maintain the gutter and all driveway sawcuts will be sealed with joint filler upon completion of the driveway apron replacement.**
- **Please note that neither the Town of Enfield nor the contractor will be responsible for damage to sprinkler systems or other landscape amenities, either above or below ground, located within the Town's Right of Way.** The Town's Right of Way typically

extends 10' from the edge of pavement into front yards. It is the individual landowner's responsibility to remove sprinkler systems or landscape amenities in front of the landowner's property before the contractor commences work. Sprinkler systems and landscape amenities that are left in the Right of Way will be removed by the contractor, as needed, in order to complete the project.

- **New curbing will be installed on all streets. For the first 24 hours after it is placed, the curbing is easily damaged. Please use extra care not to drive or step on it.**
- As with all construction projects, residents should expect heavy equipment and trucks on the road during construction.
- An Inspector will be on site during construction and easily identifiable by a yellow safety vest labeled Enfield Inspector on his/her back. This Inspector is your initial point of contact for any questions or concerns during construction.

The Town of Enfield appreciates your patience and cooperation. We apologize for any inconvenience caused by the reconstruction as we seek to improve the Town's roadways for all residents.
