PROGRAM POLICIES RELATED TO COVID-19

- **If you or anyone in your household does not feel well for ANY REASON, please do not attend the program.**
- Please notify us if you or someone in your household tests positive for COVID-19 on the day of the program or in the 14 day immediately following the program.
- Please do not arrive more than 10 minutes before to the start of the program.
- Masks **MUST** be worn by parents at all times and by participants during non-active times, such as signing in and out and using the restroom.
- Sign in and out will be contactless and conducted verbally. When signing in and out, please maintain a social distance of at least 6 feet between yourself and others.
- Each participant **MUST** be accompanied by one parent/guardian during the program.
- Upon arrival, a visual and verbal health screening will be conducted by program staff.
- Hand sanitizer and restrooms will be available for participants and parents to use during the program. Hands must be sanitized/washed after signing in, after using the restroom and as needed.
- Peer-to-peer and instructor-to-peer contact will not be allowed at any time during the program. Participants will be socially distanced for the duration of the program.
- Equipment will not be shared to the best extent possible. Used equipment will be sanitized before and after the program and during the program as needed.
- Personal items will not be shared during the program.
- Participants must follow the instructor's directions to keep socially distanced throughout the program.
- Participants should bring all of their belongings with them when they leave - any items left behind will be discarded.
- If moved indoors due to weather: Only one parent/guardian per participant will be allowed in the building. Siblings of any age will not be allowed in the building at any time. Masks **MUST** be worn by parents/guardians at all times when inside.
- **Policies are subject to change based on new local, State or Federal regulations. We will communicate any changes via email.**
