We are looking for people who are interested in working as a Lifeguard for the Enfield Recreation Department this summer and beyond. Qualified candidates can become certified through the Recreation Department at a significantly reduced rate.

To qualify for the lifeguarding class at a reduced rate, interested candidates must do the following...

- **Be a minimum 16 years of age by September 30, 2022.**
- Submit a pre-employment screening application by April 28, 2022.
- Upon selection, submit full payment of \$100.00 by May 3, 2022.
- Attend and successfully complete the pre-test, in-water requirements. *Date TBD (early May).*
- Successfully complete the online and in person training.
- Applicants will be scheduled for an employment interview in late May. Candidates selected for employment and who work through the end of the summer, will be issued a class refund in the amount of \$50.00, making your certification only \$50.00!
- **Not interested in working, but want to take the class? Limited spaces may be available for the full class rate of \$350.00. Please call the office for details.**
