We are looking for people who are interested in working as a Lifeguard for the Enfield Recreation Department this summer and beyond. Qualified candidates can become certified through the Recreation Department at cost of the Red Cross Certification. There is NO additional fee for training beyond the certification card fee assessed by the Red Cross.

**To qualify for the lifeguarding class, interested candidates must do the following...**

- Be a minimum 16 years of age by September 30, 2023.
- Submit a pre-employment screening by April 25, 2023 at 4:00 PM to the Recreation Office.
- Successfully complete a pre-employment interview on April 27 or 28.

### **UPON SELECTION FOR THE CLASS, PARTICIPANTS MUST...**

- Complete the MyRec.com Participant Form by May 1.
- Register via the Red Cross Blended Learning Class and pay the certification fee of \$42.00 by May 1.
- Submit an Employment Application via [www.enfield-ct.gov/hr](http://www.enfield-ct.gov/hr) by May 5.
- Successfully complete the online and in-person training.

Upon successful certification, new lifeguards will be scheduled for an employment interview with the Department before May 26, 2023.

*Please note: taking this class does not guarantee employment.*
